In 2019, Emma and the team at Philip Mould & Co. unearthed the earliest European portrait miniature of a black sitter: a <u>portrait miniature of Zaga Christ (c.1608-1638)</u> by Giovanna Garzoni (1600-1670). The discovery and the miniature's subsequent acquisition by the <u>Allen Art Memorial Museum</u> were featured in <u>The New York Times</u>, <u>The Guardian</u>, <u>Art Herstory</u> and <u>Art Daily</u>. In 2020, the miniature was included in the Victoria & Albert Museum's exhibition 'Renaissance Watercolours', as well as <u>'The Greatness of the Universe'</u> in the art of Giovanna Garzoni at the Palazzo Pitti.
