
LADY LEIGHTON DISCOVERY - MEDIA COVERAGE

A portrait miniature by Nicholas Hilliard (1547-1619) being offered by The Limner Company at London Art Week is thought to depict Elizabeth, Lady Leighton (née Knollys) (1549-c.1605), the lady-in-waiting to Queen Elizabeth I who caught the eye of Sir Walter Raleigh. Emma Rutherford and Elizabeth Goldring recently identified the sitter, hitherto catalogued only as an unknown lady, and their discovery was featured in <u>The Guardian</u> on Sunday 1 December.
