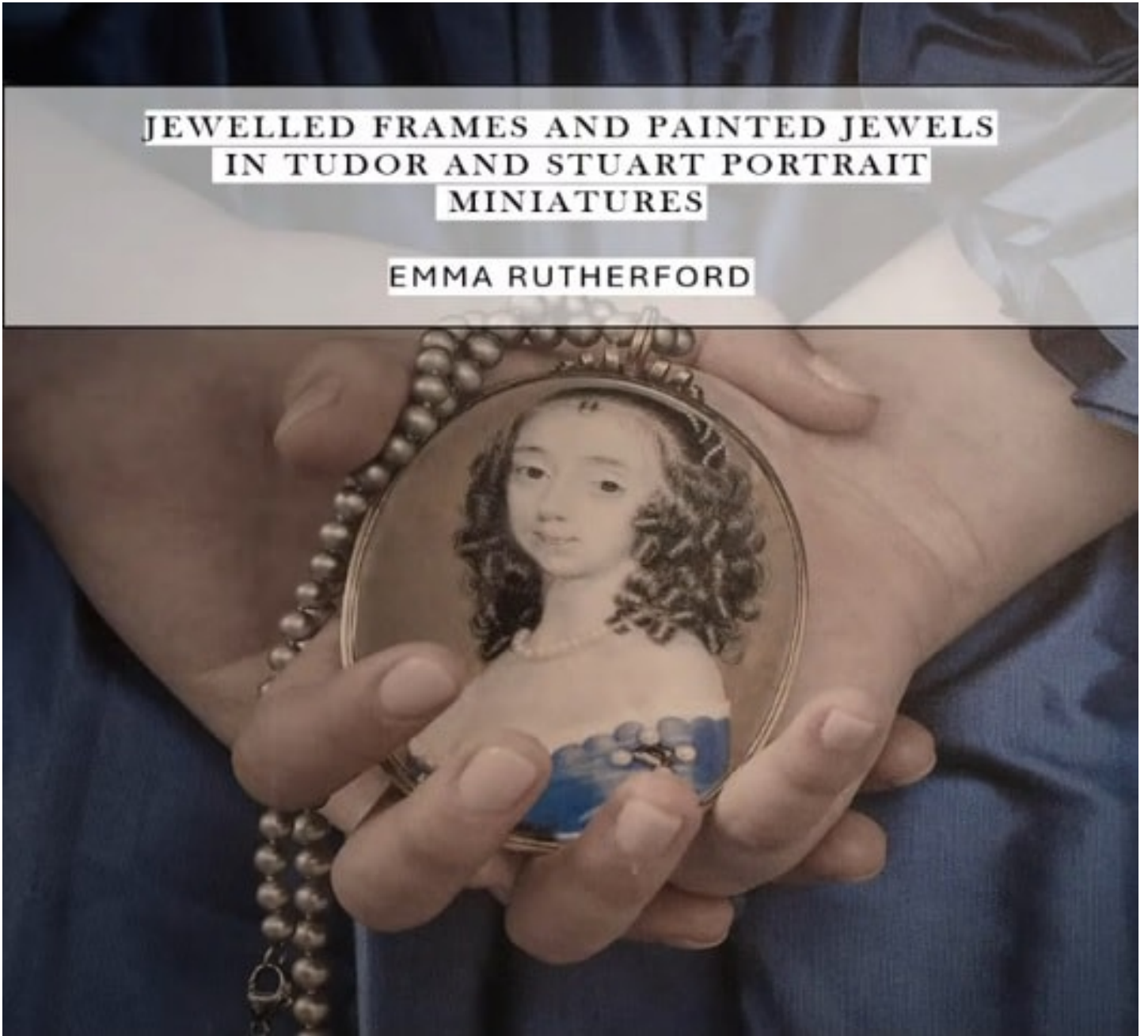

## JEWELLED FRAMES AND PAINTED JEWELS IN TUDOR AND STUART PORTRAIT MINIATURES

In this talk, Emma examines jewelled frames and painted jewels in Tudor and Stuart portrait miniatures, including a miniature recently [discovered by Emma to depict Lady Mary, later Queen Mary I \(Compton Verney Collection\)](#). In the portrait, Mary wears a necklace that was likely given to her by her father, King Henry VIII, and was key to the sitter's identification.
