In 2017, Emma uncovered a [portrait miniature of Charles Dickens \(1812-1870\)](#) by Margaret Gillies (1803-1887), which had been thought lost for over 130 years. The miniatures captures Dickens aged 31 as an emerging literary star in the midst of writing his masterwork, 'A Christmas Carol'. When the portrait was unveiled with a [Christmas exhibition](#) in 2018, press coverage included articles in [The Guardian](#), [The Times](#), [CNN](#), [The Telegraph](#), [Evening Standard](#), [The Daily Mail](#) and [Understanding British Portraits](#).
